Leeds already has too few affordable homes, whether you want to rent or to buy. Just to meet known needs, we need to build 20,000 affordable homes a year.

So what is our Tory/LibDem council doing? Under cover of “regeneration” schemes like EASEL, the council is knocking down good, affordable council houses in order to build unaffordable houses for sale to the rich. For example, the council's EASEL scheme will result in a net loss of 3,000 affordable homes.

This is not just a Tory/LibDem scheme. It was created by the last Labour council!

The Alliance for Green Socialism is part of a joint campaign in these local elections. The Socialist Green Unity Coalition offers a genuine alternative. It includes the Socialist Party, Alliance for Workers Liberty, Democratic Labour, Socialist Alliance and others.
